This photo was taken using my iPhone XR at 4:24 PM April 13, 2023, at around the same time the chess game shown was played. This game was played on my computer located in my house in Brooklyn. This online chess game was played between me, username “Abo3sam”, with the black pieces against a random opponent, username “Charlizard1”, with the white pieces hosted on the Chess.com website. This is a five-minute chess game, meaning that each of the players is allotted 5 minutes on the clock to make the moves. After 30 moves, where my opponent makes the move rook to e1, it becomes my turn to play, with over 3 minutes to spare, I spot and make the best move, which is queen to h4, taking the white pawn and checkmating the opponent, winning the game!
